Students will apply for housing after being admitted to BISU. Housing on campus is limited, so it is recommended that students apply for housing immediately upon receiving their admissions email by sending the e-mail to the School Counselor.

Health Insurance

All students must purchase medical insurance covering accidental injuries, serious illnesses, and hospitalization. China Ping An Insurance Company offers group Comprehensive Insurance which covers accidental injuries and hospitalization. Each individual needs to pay RMB 800 Yuan for one year or RMB 400 Yuan for half a year. Each of the insured students will be given an Insurance Card. The Card should be properly kept. In times of necessary medical treatment, the insured student should call the 24-hour service line, 400-810-5119 or 010-67185217 for assistance before going to the doctor. Language Requirements

Applicants who choose the English-taught courses are required to fulfill one of the following criteria: TOEFL (PBT) 550 / TOEFL (iBT) 80 / IELTS 6.5 or equivalent. (Applicants from the partner institutions which programs are fully conducted in English are exempted from the above language requirements with the letter of proof.)

Applicants who choose the Chinese-taught courses are required to fulfill one of the following criteria: an intermediate Chinese user or equivalent to HSK 5.

NOTE: Chinese language programs are open to applicants of all Chinese proficiency levels.
