

Medical Examination Requirements (For Non-local Students)

All new students at the City University of Macau are required to undergo a medical examination in accordance with University regulations as a condition of admission. It is the student's responsibility to obtain and pay for that examination. Students should submit the completed Pre-Entrance Medical Examination Report prior to course registration. Not completing and submitting this form will result in your registration being incomplete.

1. Valid Period for Medical Examination:

All new students must complete the medical examination and submit a completed Pre- Entrance Medical Examination Report issued by the University within 3 months before course registration.

2. Eligible Medical Institution:

- Mainland China students should complete their medical examinations at any Public Hospitals at the County Level or above.
 - (Mainland undergraduate students may instead submit the copy of their medical examination reports for China's National Higher Education Entrance Examination in the current year).
- Hong Kong, Taiwan and Overseas students should complete their medical examinations at any public hospital or medical institution recognized by the government for registration in their countries.
- Mainland China, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Overseas students may also complete their medical examinations at Kiang Wu Hospital in Macau (Tel: +853 8295 8501, Website: www.kwh.org.mo). Before visiting the medical institution, please visit our webpage (www.cityu.edu.mo/registry-information-download-forms/) to download the Pre-Entrance Medical Examination Report (Macau/Hong Kong/Taiwan and Overseas Area) and bring along for your visit.

3. Documents to Bring to Exam:

- I.D. Card or Passport or Exit-entry permit for travelling to and from Hong Kong and Macau (EEP):
- One 1.5 inch recent photograph (adhered a photo to the report form);
- Pre-Entrance Medical Examination Report Form issued by City University of Macau;
- Admission Notice issued by City University of Macau (if required).

4. Important Notice:

- 4.1 The first part of Pre-Entrance Medical Examination Report should be filled in front of the doctor.
- 4.2 Before undergoing medical examination, please maintain a healthy daily routine, and avoid rigorous exercise and excessive eating, in order not to affect the examination results.
- 4.3 All contact lens wearers are required to wear glasses to the eye examinations.
- 4.4 Female examinees should not collect urine sample during menstruation. It should be collected three days after the end of menstruation.
- 4.5 Female examinees who are pregnant or believe they may be pregnant should not take any X-ray examination.
